AMENDMENT OF STATUTORY MEASURE - RECORDS AND RETURNS IN RESPECT OF

MAIZE, OILSEEDS, SORGHUM AND WINTER CEREAL

47 of 1996), hereby –

(a) publishes, as set out in the Schedule hereunder, the amendments to the statutory

measure established by Government Notice No. R.606 of 4 June 2008, as amended

by Government Notices No's. R.826 of 7 October 2011, R.68 of 29 January 2016 and

R.1548 of 29 November 2019; and

(b) declares that the said amendments shall come into operation on the date of

publication hereof.

SCHEDULE

The Statutory Measure for Maize, Oilseeds, Sorghum and Winter Cereal as published by Government Notice No. 606 of 4 June 2008 as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

- 1. Amendment of clause 5: Records to be kept by end-consumers, importers, storers, exporters and processors of maize, oilseeds, sorghum and winter cereal
- 1.1 By replacing sub-clause 5.2 (b) with the following sub-clause:
 - (b) Producer deliveries-
 - All grain or oilseeds received directly from the farm of a producer on his premises according to province of production.
 - (ii) In addition hereto, all maize received directly from a producer on his premises per class and grade on a national basis.
- 1.2 By replacing sub-clause 5.2 (I) with the following sub-clause:
 - (I) Closing stock-
 - (i) The closing stock of all grain or oilseeds physically on his premises on the last day of a calendar month.
 - (ii) In addition hereto, the closing stock of maize physically on his premises per class and grade on a national basis.
- Commencement and period of validity

These amendments to the statutory measure shall come into operation on the date of publication hereof and shall lapse on 30 April 2024.
