Following Market Notice [411A/2025](#) and [411B/2025](#) of 05 December 2025, the JSE is pleased to provide the final differentials for the 2026-27 marketing season.

Maximum Standard Daily Outstanding Storage Rate for Soybean

The maximum standard daily outstanding storage rate for marketing season 1 March 2026 – 28 February 2027 will be adjusted based on the annual percentage change in the PPI for final manufactured goods of 2.9%, published in December 2025. As a result, the maximum standard outstanding daily storage rate applied to outstanding storage in completion of a futures contract will increase from R1.18 to **R1.21** per ton per day. Please ensure that all storage is paid up to and including 28 February 2026 when making delivery of JSE silo receipts issued in the previous marketing season.

The market is hereby reminded that the following foreign origins will be accepted for delivery in fulfillment of futures contracts without any origin discount.
